Travel Tips

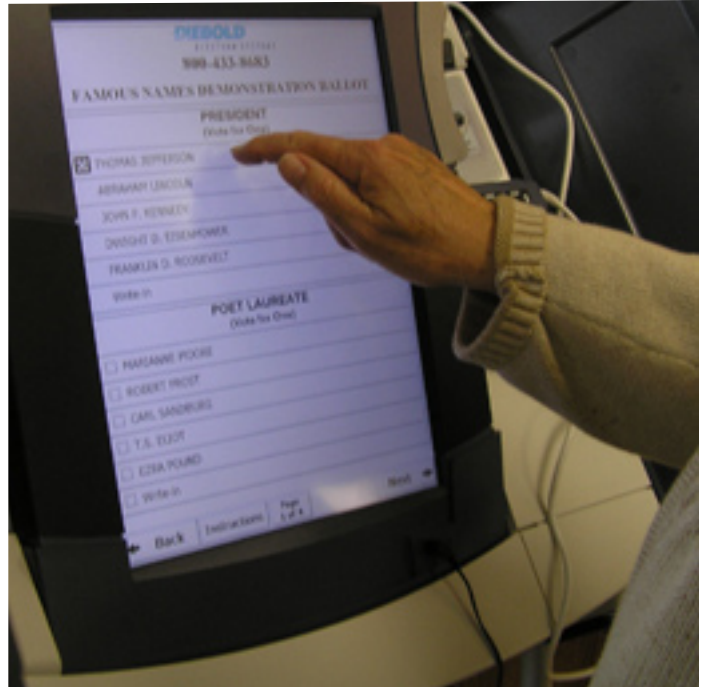

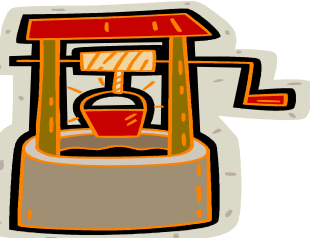
